On 27 January 1935, the first statutes of the cooperative association Folkets Hus å Aspö u.p.a. were adopted.

Master pilot John Löfgren leased a plot of land and the responsible builder was Arvid Karlsson and with the efforts of many volunteer employees, the building was erected which is still, albeit in modernized and extended condition, located near Aspö School.

In 1937, the first outdoor dance floor was built, which was replaced by a new one in the early 1960s. The building, which was not in such good condition at the time, was also renovated.

During the war years, the military seized the building, therefore the business was almost closed, but in the 1960s Folkets Hus gained about ten new members who activated the business again.

Municipal grants were applied for and obtained to renovate the property. A well was drilled and water pipes were installed to avoid having to fetch water from the school's well.

In the late 1970s, the sewage issue was also arranged so that toilets and showers could be installed.

## Aspö Folkets Hus



Many of Aspö's associations and private individuals have over the years used the premises for various activities, including dance, study circles, gymnastics, information meetings, auctions, parties, etc.

Aspö School has also located its school gymnastics there, as the school does not have its own gymnasium.

Folkets Hus has also served as the district's nurse clinic but this was closed down, it was so bad with visits, so it indicated that the inhabitants of Aspö seemed to be so healthy that it was not needed.

The most well-known activity for the public is probably the former annual Midsummer celebration arr. Of Aspö shooting association and Drottningskärs If which was a big feature during the summer on Aspö.

Today, the premises are used for gymnastics of various kinds, including rental for parties, parties, weddings, meetings, flea markets and much much more.
